## East Swimming Long Course Championships 2018 - Update

It has recently been announced that the 800m Freestyle for Men and 1500m Freestyle for Women will be added to the programme at the British Swimming and Swim England Summer Championships.

East Swimming is committed to providing opportunity for the region's swimmers to post a time in the qualification window that might qualify them for these national event. The opportunity will be offered to all of the age groups that make up the East Swimming Long Course Championships.

The session will take place in the early afternoon of Saturday 19th May 2018 at Basildon Sporting Village.

To compete in the Women's 1500m Freestyle, swimmers will need to have obtained the regional 800m qualifying time for their respective age group.

To compete in the Men's 800m Freestyle, swimmers will need to have obtained the regional 400m or 1500m qualifying time for their respective age group.
