Welcome back to the start of another season!



SWIM SERPTENTINE FUNDRAISER

BSSC Masters swimmers **Jake Lloyd**, **Laura Burgess**, **Niamh James** and **Geoff Short** took on Swim Serpentine at London's Hyde Park on Saturday 14th September, swimming 18 miles between them.

Jake raised £362 for the Club – thank you, Jake!

Meanwhile, **Rachael Hunt** competed in Ultraswim Greece, a grueling 33.3km open-water marathon around Skopelos, Greece. The event comprises six swims over four days, and Rachael secured a top-three place in her category – her first ever podium place. Congratulations Rachael - a massive achievement.



HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

Swim England Hertfordshire has released the conditions, schedule and

qualifying/consideration times for Hertfordshire County Championships which will take place in January and February 2025. Key documents can be <u>found here</u>.

Remember, when you are looking at the entry times for next year's Counties, you will need to consider the age your child will be on 31st December 2025. For example, a child born in 2012 who is 12 this year (2024) will need to meet the 13 year old Qualifying or Consideration Times for the next Championships in January 2025.

We have also updated our <u>Guide to Counties</u> and you can find a recording of last year's Counties <u>here</u>. If your swimmer is new to Counties, they might want to watch some of last year's event so they know what to expect.

Finally, if you're unsure whether your swimmer has got a Counties QT or CT, go onto Swim Manager, and under your swimmer's account have a look at the 'Qualifying' tab. All QTs and CTs will show up in green.

BRAINTREE SEASON STARTER

September was rounded off nicely with a trip to Braintree for Braintree & Bocking Swimming Club's Season Starter. For some of our swimmers, including **Erin** and **Ailbhe**, it was their first taste of competitive swimming.

A massive **111 top three places** (57 gold, 31 silver, 23 bronze) were secured, and 54% of swims were PBs!

NATIONAL COUNTY TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS

BSSC's **Dylan** and **Ella** were on great form as they travelled north to represent Hertfordshire at Swim England's National County Team Championships 2024 on Sunday 6th October at Ponds Forge in Sheffield.

Dylan (15) and Ella (16) joined 25 other top swimmers from clubs including Hatfield, City of St Albans, Cheshunt and Watford to make up the Hertfordshire Team.

Hertfordshire finished 9th out of the 18 Division Two teams, meaning the county **easily avoids relegation** and keeps its place in Division Two for next year's Championships. This is Hertfordshire's **highest finishing position since 2019**. <u>Read more online</u>.



EAST REGION MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Sunday 29th September saw BSSC Masters swimmers **Jake Lloyd**, **Niamh James**, **Callum Davis**, **Lucy Wheeler** and **Sally Winter** travel to Newmarket for Swim England's East Region Masters Championships.

The team were in fantastic form, with **16 medals** (14 of them gold!) won. Highlights from the day included the 4 x 50m freestyle and medley relays, with Niamh, Callum, Jake and Lucy taking gold in both events.

Alyson Fordham continued her **record-breaking streak**, taking two seconds off her own British 200m backstroke record with a time of 2:51.51. <u>Read more online</u>.
