We've had so much to write about over the past few months! Since our last newsletter in March, BSSC has hosted a fantastic Regional Qualifier with Harlow Penguins, celebrated incredible swims at Long Course meets including the prestigious London Legacy Meet, saw 32 swimmers qualify for Regionals... before achieving the most successful Regional Championships on record. But, the season's not finished yet! Over the next few months we look forward to Club Champs 2025, the Team Steel Meet in Sheffield, Peanuts League Rounds 2 and 3 and summer Nationals at Ponds Forge.

In this edition of Babble, we celebrate highlights from 2025's Regional Championships, recognise newly-broken Club records, share upcoming dates for your diary, and take a look back at an absolutely fantastic Round 1 of Peanuts League.

BSSC CLUB NEWS

EAST REGION LONG COURSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

This year's Regional Championships saw BSSC bring home **20 medals** (6 Golds, 7 Silver and 7 Bronze). This is huge improvement on 2024's four medals, and is the Club's **best-ever Regionals result**.

Thirty-two BSSC swimmers competed against the top swimmers from the six eastern Counties of England – Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire, Essex, Hertfordshire, Norfolk, Suffolk – at the Swim England East Region Long Course (50m) Championships.

Qualifiers and top-eight finishes:

- 32 qualifiers (vs 25 in 2024)
- 18 individual finalists in total (vs 11 in 2024)
- Junior swimmers well represented 10 swimmers took part in 14/under finals
- 57 top-eight finishes (vs 31 in 2024)
- 20 medals (up from four in 2024!)

Weekend One of the competition kicked off on Friday 28th March with events for the 15/over swimmers at UEA Sportspark in Norwich.

The weekend started with the 800m Freestyle, with BSSC represented by 17-year-old **Brandon Macdonald-Williams**.

Over the following two days, 16 of BSSC's senior swimmers took part in 54 swims across heats and finals, and brought home five medals:

- Molly Greatbatch 200m Breaststroke, Gold
- Dylan Davenport 100m and 50m Freestyle, Silver
- Lucy Wheeler 100m Freestyle, Bronze
- Rose Conday 100m Freestyle, Bronze





Weekend Two (Saturday 3rd to Monday 5th May) saw the 15/overs return to Norwich, with **Brandon Macdonald-Williams** and **Oliver Tom** taking on the 1500m Freestyle, and **Ella Greatbatch** and **Dylan Davenport** adding to BSSC's medal count with bronzes in the 50m Breaststroke and 200m Freestyle respectively.

On Bank Holiday Monday, 11 of BSSC's junior swimmers (14/under) began their Regionals campaign.


The youngsters had an amazing day, with nine out of 11 swimmers reaching the finals, and four swimmers securing four medals between them:

- Summer Miller 100m Butterfly, Gold
- Noah Conroy 100m Butterfly, Silver
- Taras Boiko 100m Butterfly, Silver
- Harrison Dodwell 50m Breaststroke, Bronze



Weekend Three saw BSSC's juniors (14/unders) finish the competition in style as they headed to Inspire: Luton Sports Village on Saturday 10th and Sunday 11th May.

The final weekend kicked off with the 800m Freestyle, with 12 year old **Noah Conroy** representing BSSC.



The juniors then had a packed weekend of racing, with 9 out of 14 swimmers reaching finals, 19 finals raced, and nine more medals won:

Five swimmers made their Regional debuts

For five BSSC swimmers it was their first taste of a regional level competition: Linke Groenewald, Kenny Millsom, Luca Tse, Sophie Tom and Millie Cass.

Kenny had a fantastic first Regional Championships, reaching **finals for all three of his races** (50m, 100m and 200m Breaststroke) and winning silver in the 200m Breaststroke final.

At the end of Sunday's racing, Swim England East Region presented Top Swimmer Awards for each age group, with **Summer Miller** awarded 3rd Top Girl Swimmer in the 13 years category.




SUMMER NATIONALS QUALIFIERS

Dylan, Ella, Rose, Molly and **Kirsty** will be competing at the Aquatics GB Next Gen Championships at Ponds Forge from 19-25 July.

They'll return to Sheffield along with **Summer**, **Edie**, **Brandon** and **Niamh** - for the GoCardless Swim England National Summer Meet, which kicks off on 29 July.



About Nationals...

The <u>Aquatics GB Next Gen Championships</u> sees the top-ranked swimmers in Britain race against each other to be crowned British summer champion. Qualifying swims have to happen at Level 1 (Long Course) meets in a defined March-May window.

Running soon after the Aquatics GB Next Gen Championships is the <u>Swim England</u> <u>National Summer Meet</u>, where the next batch of fastest swimmers are invited to compete. Invites are again based on qualifying swims from Level 1 (Long Course) meets in a defined March-May window.


SWIMMERS OF THE MONTH


BUTTERFLY CLINIC WITH LAURA STEPHENS

On 29th April, BSSC hosted our first-ever **Butterfly Clinic** with 2024 World Aquatics 200m Butterfly **gold medalist and Olympic swimmer** Laura Stephens.

Laura kicked off the morning with a motivating talk about her swimming journey, starting with success at the 2012 County Championships (where she won every event in her agegroup!), **Olympic trials at 13** and medaling at the 2015 and 2016 **European Junior Championships** before the transition to senior swimming. Laura then spoke about her experiences as a senior swimmer, including the **2021 Tokyo and 2024 Paris Olympic Games**.

Finishing off her talk, Laura focused on **five key lessons learnt** during her swimming journey - **work hard**, **attention to detail**, **resilience**, **self belief** and the importance of **enjoying the journey**!

We then moved to the pool to work with Laura on Butterfly skills, drills, starts and turns, before Laura joined swimmers in the pool. The 40 swimmers from BSSC (and other clubs in the area) left the Clinic feeling motivated, inspired and ready for their next Butterfly race!

S&C WITH MADDOCKS FITNESS

Craig Maddocks from Maddocks Fitness, our Strength & Conditioning partner, delivered his **Dryland Training and Swimming Nutrition Performance** talk to swimmers and parents on 22nd April. Craig focused on his four pillars of dryland training (training, fuel, regeneration and drive), nutrition, preventing injury and preparing for races.

BSSC's Strength & Conditioning programme recently received a boost in the form of a £2,000 **training equipment grant** from Bishop's Stortford Town Council.

This generous funding has enabled the Club to purchase new dryland training equipment including **dumb bells**, **resistance ropes**, **skipping ropes** and **exercise mats**.

Dryland training is designed to help improve swimmers' fitness, performance and recovery – in turn, resulting in improved performance, more effective training and reduced chance of injury.

The equipment grant is part of a larger sum awarded by Bishop's Stortford Town Council that will enable the Club to invest in updated software and AV to run and manage swimming meets, together with pool training equipment such as backstroke ledges, swim bungee cords and bridge buoys.

BSSC X HARLOW PENGUINS REGIONAL QUALIFIER

BSSC and Harlow Penguins Swimming Club hosted their second joint Regional Qualifier Open Meet at Harlow Leisurezone on Saturday 22nd March.

We welcomed over **300 swimmers**, together with a packed gallery of 300 supporters and spectators from clubs across the region including Epping Forest, New Hall, Harwich and Brentwood.

BSSC was well represented, with 80 swimmers from across the Club – from our Junior squads to Masters swimmers. Our swimmers raced in 298 events, with 198 races resulting in personal best times. Thirty-three swimmers **PB'd in every race**.

Our overall medal haul was 177 medals – 86 gold, 53 silver and 38 bronze.

Ten swimmers from the Juniors squad were competing in their very first open meet, with three of them going on to secure top-three places: **Ruby Penny** (Silver, 50m Backstroke), **Lara Crotty** (Silver, 50m Butterfly) and **Otis Mastin** (Gold, 50m Breaststroke).

Two BSSC swimmers, **Ella** and **Niamh**, competed in the Aquatics GB Championships at the London Aquatics Centre from 15-20 April.

The biggest domestic meet of the year welcomed around 1,000 swimmers and para swimmers to the nation's capital as athletes such as James Guy, Poppy Maskill and Ben Proud all took gold as the latest **Olympic and Paralympic cycle** kicked in to gear.

PEANUTS LEAGUE: ROUND ONE

Saturday 10th May saw BSSC's **youngest swimmers** take on the first round of Peanuts League 2025 at The Haberdashers' Boys' School in Elstree.

The Peanuts League consists of three separate galas held between May and June. Swimmers aged 9 to 12 compete in a mix of individual age group races (9yr, U11yr, U12yr, U13yr) and relays. BSSC is currently in **Peanuts League's Division One**, alongside eleven other Hertfordshire swimming clubs including Hatfield, Watford, City of St Albans, Harpenden and Stevenage.

For many of our youngest swimmers, Peanuts League is their first time competing in a team event – for some, it was their **first taste of competitive swimming**. They all put in amazing performances, working together as a team, supporting each other and cheering on their team mates.



After Round One, BSSC finished in **second position on the night** and **third in the league** (behind City of St Albans A Team and Hatfield), putting us in an excellent position going into Round Two. Round Two will be held on Saturday 7th June in Hitchin, followed by the third and final Round on Saturday 28th June at a venue to be announced.
