Meanwhile, our world-ranking Masters have been setting records and winning multiple medals at the British Masters Championships.

AQUATICS GB NEXT GEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025



The Aquatics GB Next Gen Championships (previously known as the British Summer Championships) sees the top-ranked swimmers in Britain race against each other to be crowned British summer champion.

Qualifying swims have to happen at Level 1 (Long Course) meets in a defined March-May window and this year four current BSSC swimmers were fast enough to receive invitations to compete. The 2025 event was held in the Ponds Forge International Pool in Sheffield from 19-25 July.



BSSC's youngest swimmers were **Molly Greatbatch** and **Rose Conday**, both swimming in the 15 years age group.

Molly had a **fantastic swim** with the 200m Breaststroke, finishing 12th with a time of 2:47.10.

Rose secured a **personal best time** to qualify in second place for the 50m Freestyle Final. She achieved another PB in the Final, finishing with a **bronze medal** in a time of 26.75. She was then back the next day for the 100m freestyle, where she finished **7**th in the Final.

Rose also **broke a Club Record** with her 50m Freestyle time!



AQUATICS GB NEXT GEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025






Dylan Davenport was invited to compete in the 16 years age group in the 50m and 100m freestyle.

He had a great swim in the 50m Freestyle heats, swimming a personal best time of **24.73** to secure his place in the final where he finished as **10**th **fastest in GB**.

He also PB'd in the **100m Freestyle heats**, with a time of 54.64.

Ella Greatbatch competed in the 17/18 years age group, qualifying for the **50m Breaststroke Final**, where she finished in 9th place with a time of 33.47.

She was then back the next day for the **100m Breaststroke**, competing in the tough 17/18 years age group. She finished in 30th place (15th out of the 17 year olds) in 1:15.87.



SWIM ENGLAND NATIONAL SUMMER MEET 2025



Running soon after the Aquatics GB Next Gen Championships is the Swim England National Summer Meet, where the next batch of fastest swimmers are invited to compete. Invites are again based on qualifying swims from Level 1 (Long Course) meets in a defined March-May window, and this year seven current BSSC swimmers were fast enough to receive invitations to compete.

Thirteen year old **Summer Miller** was our youngest competitor and performed superbly at her first National level event, reaching the Finals for both of her races.

She finished in 9th place in the 100m Fly, before going onto **win bronze** in the **200m Fly** on the final day of the event.





Rose Conday continued her successful form from the previous week's racing. She competed in the **200m Freestyle**, where she finished 14th out of 38 swimmers.

She then **PB'd in the 100m Backstroke** heats and secured her place in the Final with a time of 1:07.54 – before going on to take **Silver in the Final** with another PB of 1:06.41! She also **finished 6th** in the 50m Backstroke Final.

SWIM ENGLAND NATIONAL SUMMER MEET 2025



Ella Greatbatch reached the Final of the 17/18 years 200m Breaststroke, where she **finished in 4th place** (very narrowly missing out on a medal by 0.04 seconds) with a time of 2:44.98 – a **personal best** and taking nearly three seconds off her heats time.

Niamh James competed in the 18/over category; a personal best time of 1:06.54 secured Niamh a place in the **100m Backstroke Final**, where she finished in 9th place. A further PB in the **200m Backstroke Final** secured Niamh a **Bronze medal** with a time of 2:22.23. She also competed in the **200m Individual Medley**, where she finished 12th in the heats.



Congratulations also go to **Edie Foster** who was 21st out of 44 swimmers in the 100m 14/15 years Freestyle heats with a **PB of 1:01.24**, **Molly Greatbatch** who was 14th in the 50m Breaststroke and **11th out of 44 swimmers** in the 100m Breaststroke heats, and **Brandon Macdonald-Williams** who finished 13th in the 17 years **1500m Freestyle**.

OPEN MEETS, TEAM GALAS & CHAMPIONSHIPS

PEANUTS LEAGUE ROUND 3

Peanuts League 2025 concluded in thrilling style on Saturday 28th June, as BSSC's youngest swimmers battled it out to see who would win the Division One of the Hertfordshire Peanuts League 2025.

Following a second-position finish in round one in May, and a win for the second round earlier in June, it was all to play for going into the third and final round at Haberdashers' Boys' School in Elstree.

It was an exciting night of racing, with nearly all races going down to the wire. The swimmers did incredibly - securing 30 top-three places. Ultimately, City of St Albans A Team took the win, finishing ten points ahead of BSSC.

Noah Conroy and Sophie Tom, both 12, collected the runner-up pennant on behalf of BSSC.



Despite disappointment over not topping the league, finishing as runner-up in the League is a remarkable achievement and enormous progress on last year's results, where BSSC finished tenth out of 12 teams and at times had to dig deep to stay up in Division One.

CITY OF SHEFFIELD TEAM STEEL MEET

A small squad of BSSC swimmers travelled up to Sheffield for City of Sheffield Swim Squad's Team Steel Meet at Ponds Forge. Nearly everyone left the meet with at least one medal or a late-season personal best, and it was a fantastic opportunity for those who qualified for Nationals to familiarise themselves with Ponds Forge before Nationals kicked off the following month.

MASTERS BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIPS

A squad of eight BSSC Masters were in action at the British Masters Championships at the London Aquatics Centre from Friday 13th to Sunday 15th June.

The British Masters Championships is the highest level of domestic Masters swimming in Great Britain. The event, which takes place in a long course 50m pool, rotates between England, Scotland and Wales every year.

BSSC's swimmers came away with an impressive 18 medals: 12 gold, 3 silver and 3 bronze.



With Britain's fastest Masters swimmers in action, it's not unusual to see world, European and British records broken at the meet. BSSC's **Lizzie Bellinger** certainly delivered, with a brilliant **British Masters record-breaking swim** in the 100m Butterfly (45-49 years) in a time of 1:08.54!

Our relay "dream team" of Callum Davis, Lucy Wheeler, Niamh James and Jake Lloyd took **gold in two relays** – the Mixed 4 x 50m Medley Relay (72 years+) and Mixed 4 x 100m Freestyle Relay (72 years+).

Sally Winter (65-69 years) and **Lucy Wheeler** (25-29 years) also secured **double golds** in the 200m Freestyle.

BSSC finished in **16th position** overall out of over 200 represented clubs – a considerable achievement with a squad of eight swimmers competing!






WELFARE OFFICER
